Abstracts will be judged based on appropriateness to the conference theme, significance for unitary science, clarity, rigor, soundness of findings and conclusions, significance of the implications, and overall quality.

Submissions will be emailed to the address below and will include 2 pages:

1. *Cover page* containing: abstract title, names and credential of all presenters, contact information (must include email address) for the first presenter, and type of submission (paper, poster, or either/both).
2. *Abstract* (maximum of 250 words) identified by abstract title only (no identifying data).
3. *Deadline* for submissions: **Wednesday, May 26, 2010**. Notification of acceptance is anticipated approximately June 30, 2010
